#### **Student Right to Cancel**

Theatre of Arts, for all students, without penalty or obligation, shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100), if notice of cancellation is made prior to or on the first day of instruction or the seventh day of instruction, whichever is later.
